## **OUR BEHAVIOUR IN CHURCH**

- 1. We come to Church **ON TIME**.
- 2. We enter the Church building **QUIETLY**, without the thumping or banging of feet. The use of mobile phones during Church services is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.
- 3. We venerate in a **PIOUS** manner the holy icons. During a service, we only venerate those icons that are made available at the entrance so as not to disrupt the service.
- 4. We **NEVER** block the entrance of the Church or stand in a place that prevents others from entering the Church and finding their place.
- 5. As long as possible throughout the service, we remain **STANDING**, **STILL** and **SILENT**. And we pray.
- 6. During Church services, communication is allowed **ONLY** with God. Any other type of conversation is **SIN**.
- 7. It is necessary for **EVERYONE TO STAND** during the following parts: "Blessed is the Kingdom", "Wisdom. Arise," the Gospel reading, the Cherubic Hymn, the Symbol of Faith ("I believe"), from "Take, eat" up to the *Axion Estin* ("It is truly right"), the Lord's Prayer ("Our Father"), "The Holy Gifts for the holy people," "With fear of God," the Dismissal and every time the Priest censes or gives a blessing.
- 8. We approach Holy Communion in a **PIOUS**, **QUIET** and **ORDERLY** manner, one after the other.
- 9. Regular parishioners should always set a **GOOD EXAMPLE** of piety, patience, prayer, silence and faith. All together we are to encourage the participation of children in the services. We never criticize or disparage families with children.
- 10. We do not leave the Divine Liturgy earlier than the *Di' Efxon* ("Through the prayers of our holy fathers"). When the Divine Liturgy is completed, we receive in an **ORDERLY** and **PIOUS** manner the antidoron, **ALWAYS** from the hand of the liturgizing Priest.
- 11. After receiving the antidoron, we **VERY QUIETLY** exit from the Church Building, without engaging in disruptive greetings, embraces and discussions with friends and family.
- 12. We cooperate **FULLY** (without defiant grumbling) with the members of the Community Council in maintaining proper ecclesiastical order and decorum.
